1. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO BE MET

The Forum of Young Researchers and Professionals is ONLY FOR PEOPLE OF 35 YEARS OLD AND UNDER.

The event will take place on September 27th and 28th; your presence ON BOTH DAYS IS MANDATORY.

2. ARRIVAL TO QUEBEC

Airport:

From the airport, NO SERVICE shuttle or public transportation is available

From the airport to downtown Quebec: flat rate of \$32.50 BY CAB

From the airport to Ste-Foy (Laurier blvd.) approximately \$20.00 BY CAB

Train and bus:

A person from Via Rail or Orleans Express will direct you to your hotel when you arrive (between 5:30 in the morning until 12:30 at night). At any time, there will be taxis available.
